WHAT?

The Family Justice Centre (FJC) provides **free legal services to eligible self-represented litigants** in Ontario. Private bar family law lawyers will supervise law students in the delivery of unbundled legal services including **summary advice**, and in some cases, **document drafting**.

WHO?

The FJC was created by **Pro Bono Students Canada** to address the longstanding gaps in our family justice system.



HOW?

Intake sessions and clinics are operated virtually via **Zoom** and/or **telephone**. The FJC can provide assistance with the following **legal issues**: parenting; child support; spousal support; service issues; and, restraining orders.
